DESCRIBE DUTIES

PRINCIPAL DUTIES:

- Hire, train, and assess all course maintenance personnel.
- Train staff in proper maintenance methods and procedures while stressing quality workmanship, efficiency, and safety.

- Coordinate and assign staff members their day to day tasks.
- Assess and change manpower needs according to the seasonal needs of the operation.
- Make daily and weekly adjustments to labor needs to maximize output while minimizing hours spent and overtime.
- Collect and add up hours on time cards every Wednesday morning and bring to GM.
- Effectively plan projects with the General Manager (GM) and complete in a timely manner.
- Receive 2 to 3 bids for all projects depending on the level of expense and rationalize choice(s) with the GM.
- Procure all supplies, chemicals, parts, and fertilizes at the best value. (value = quality + price)
- Know the layout and mechanics of the golf course irrigation, and drainage system.
- Adjust irrigation needs daily depending on course needs and weather forecasts..
- With the GM and in accordance with agreed upon course needs and standards, plan next year's expense budget. This should include all costs including labor, fertilizers, turf chemicals (insecticides, herbicides, and fungicides), materials and supplies, aerifications, etc.
- Throughout the year continually assess actual expense results and effectively report any variances to the GM.
- Once a year with the GM and President, plan next year's Maintenance Department's capital budget. This should include equipment needs and course improvements.
- Effectively plan and schedule all aerifications, fertilizations, and chemical applications according to the budget and golf course play.
- Be knowledgeable in fertilizer and chemical application rates.
- Maintain detailed records of all applications of fertilizers and turf chemical. (Date, time, amounts, what, price)
- With the help of the mechanic develop procedures for maintaining the equipment in good working order (i.e. preventive maintenance).
- Communicate with the pro shop when needed to schedule maintenance tasks
- Effectively "set up" the course prior to key tournaments and functions.
- Be knowledgeable in all government regulations, i.e. Personnel, water usage, chemical and fertilizer application
- Responsible for security of equipment and building and safety of personnel.
- Make sure maintenance building superintendent office is clean, safe and well organized.
