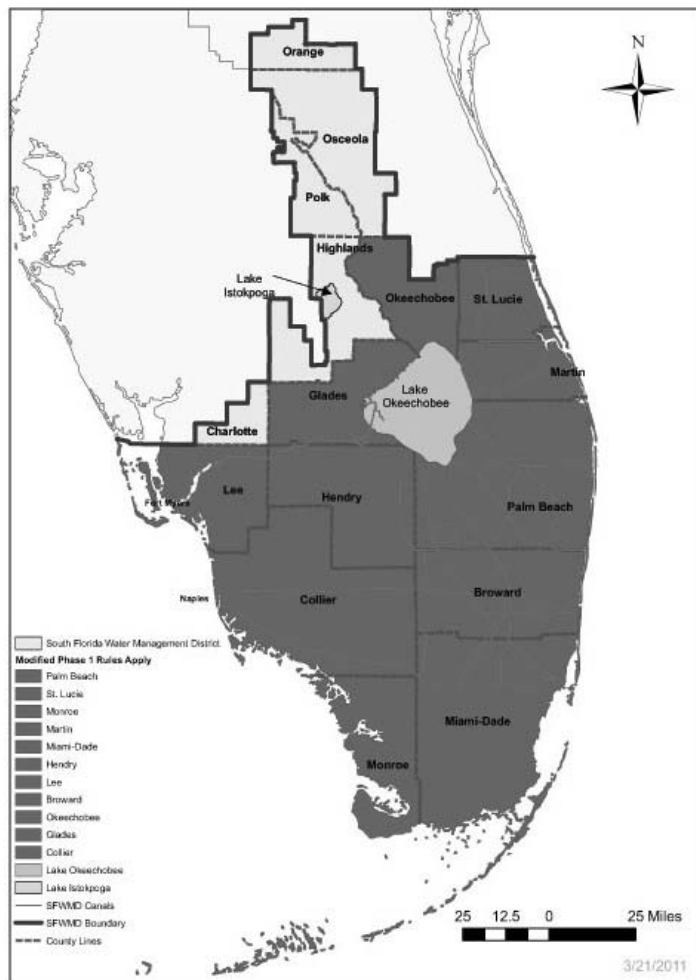
Golf Course Water Use Restrictions

For Broward, Collier, Glades, Hendry, Lee, Martin, Miami-Dade, Monroe, Okeechobee, Palm Beach and St. Lucie counties

15% Cutback

- Golf courses shall cut back on water use by 15 percent from their monthly AFSIRS-calculated allocation.
- From Aug. 7 to Oct. 31, golf courses that need to undertake re-sodding, sprigging or other course rehabilitation activities may apply for a variance from the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD).
 - SFWMD staff will consider local and regional water resource conditions when deciding whether to grant a variance authorizing a golf course to use the full monthly allocation contained in its water use permit.
 - Variance applications are available at www.sfwmd.gov/waterwatch.
- Golf courses must continue to total and report actual pumpage data to the District weekly. Data for the previous week should be reported by noon every Monday and can be entered online at www.sfwmd.gov/waterwatch.
